Application

The following standard applies to the receipt of Durum wheat

Standard

1. The wheat must be of the varieties Arrivato (A8), EGA Bellaroi (E9), Kamilaroi (K8), Wollaroi (W9), Yallaroi (Y2), Tamaroi (T15) and Gunderoi (G17).
2. Durum grades must conform to the AWB general wheat receipt standards for the ASW1 grade with the exception of the following:
 - ❖ Subject to DBS on a site by site basis

- 2 Where a load is classified at a grade lower than DR1, record on the Transaction note the additional test with the appropriate Test Code and Value. For Test Codes not listed refer to the 2003/2004 AusBulk Wheat Receipt Chart.
