VITERRA RELEASES PRELIMINARY SEGREGATION PLAN

ADELAIDE, South Australia – 19 April 2016

Viterra has released its preliminary segregation plan for the 2016/17 harvest following feedback from growers about their planting intentions this year.

Michael Hill, Viterra's Group Operations Manager, said the segregation plan had been developed following state-wide post-harvest meetings with the Strategic Site Committee Chairs and local silo committees, as well as feedback from individual growers.

"The main changes from last year include increasing the number of Compass barley segregations and adding storage capacity for lentils in line with expected increased hectares being planted," he said.

"We have released the information early to give growers a better indication of the segregations that will be at sites as they plan for the upcoming season."

Michael said it was important to note the preliminary plan was subject to change following further consultation with growers and depending on seasonal conditions.

"Some sites' segregations will be determined when we have a clearer picture of crop conditions in those areas.

"We encourage growers to provide feedback on the plan so we can work with them to reflect what is being grown in their region. They can contact their local Operations Coordinators listed on the plan or their local Strategic Site Committee Chairs," Michael said.
